Court Executive Officer Sharif Elmallah has been selected to serve as the next Court Executive Officer for the Butte County Superior Court. He will replace Court Executive Officer Kimberly Flener who will retire in September. Mr. Elmallah's last day of employment with the Glenn County Superior Court will be August 13, 2021, and he will begin working for the Butte County Superior Court on August 16, 2021.

Mr. Elmallah has served the Glenn County Superior Court as its Court Executive Officer since 2019 and previously served the Placer and Alameda County Superior Courts. He has helped guide the court through the pandemic, facility moves and the start of the renovation and expansion of the Historic Courthouse in Willows, and various administrative and operational service model changes. The court would like to thank Mr. Elmallah for his service and congratulate him on his new appointment.

Mr. Elmallah has worked closely with the Butte County Superior Court on various collaborations in his past roles and looks forward to serving the court and the people of Butte County directly, but will miss serving the court and the people of Glenn County. He is thankful to the judges of both the Glenn and Butte County Superior Courts for their confidence and support.

The Glenn County Superior Court will be conducting a public recruitment to fill its Court Executive Officer position.
