SUBJECT: 2023 Glenn County Revised Schedule of Bail
 for all Bailable Misdemeanor and Felony Offenses

Pursuant to Penal Code §1269b (c) and (d), the court is distributing the 2023 uniform countywide schedule of bail for all bailable felony and misdemeanor offenses, which is attached and effective as of January 1, 2023.

On April 6, 2020, the Judicial Council of California adopted California Rule of Court (CRC), emergency rule 4, which required the court to adopt an emergency bail schedule as specified due to the current state of emergency relating to COVID-19. On April 8, 2020, the court adopted that emergency bail schedule. On June 10, 2020, the Judicial Council of California repealed CRC, emergency rule 4 effective June 20, 2020 and directed superior courts that the countywide bail schedule that was in effect on April 5, 2020 became effective unless the court adopts a revised bail schedule. Effective June 25, 2020, the court adopted a revised bail schedule. The Revised Uniform Schedule of Bail for all Bailable Misdemeanor and Felony Offenses shall remain in effect in 2022 until repealed by the court or until a new bail schedule is adopted by the court. Revisions are as follows:

- The bail amount for all misdemeanor offenses shall be \$0 with the exception of the following misdemeanor offenses, for which the bail amount shall be \$5,000:



- The bail amounts for all individuals who have been detained following a failure to appear in court shall be the amount of bail on the charged offense plus \$5,000 for misdemeanor offenses and plus \$10,000 for felony offenses.

All other provisions of the attached bail schedule shall remain in effect.

Multiple Offenses

In the case of multiple offenses against a single defendant, bail is based on the total of the bail for each separate offense. A separate offense is an offense not subject to Penal Code § 654 – i.e., an offense, which is not just a different statement of the same crime. [Common Example: suspect enters Safeway and steals something: suspect has a prior theft conviction, so suspect is charged with PC §§ 459.5 & 496. This is § 654. If an individual is charged with multiple offenses, then those not subject to § 654 shall be aggregated.
